# ORDER ON DEFENDANT'S MOTION FOR TRANSCRIPTION OF AUDIO RECORDING

On the 30<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2016, the Court reviewed the <u>Defendant's Motion For Transcription</u> of Audio Recording.

The Court finds the motion shall be granted as follows:

Upon the defense attorney's request and the State's review the court orders that a transcription of the audio portion of the recording in connection to the above-captioned and numbered cause may be made by a certified court reporter within the office of the 97<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Attorney at a date and time agreed upon in advance by both the State and defense attorney with the following provisions:

No written or printed copy of the transcription of the audio should be published or provided by the counsel for the defendant to any other person, including the defendant himself, with the exception of clerical personnel and / or experts retained by counsel for the defendant for the purpose of trial or trial preparation.

Further, the Court orders the publication of the transcript prohibited or provided by counsel for the defendant shall extend to any person working with or at the direction of the defendant or his counsel. The Court directs counsel to notify any person working with him or under his direction and furnish a copy of the Court's order to such person.

Additionally, the Court orders that the transcription of the audio portion of the tape shall be done at the expense of the defendant.

The Court's order restricting publication shall be enforceable by contempt.
