Overview

People in the United States, including Texas, are sometimes accused of, tried for, and even convicted and imprisoned for crimes they simply did not commit. When that happens, their convictions are often upheld on direct appeal. This seminar addresses effective ways to represent your innocent client at every stage of the criminal justice process, including postconviction writs of habeas corpus.
