TCDLA Prosecutorial Conduct Committee Policy

TCDLA Prosecutorial Conduct Committee has the following steps and requirements to request for a grievance to be filed through the Texas Criminal Defense Lawyers Association.

Criteria:

- Texas Disciplinary Rules of Professional Conduct was violated
- Must effect criminal defense lawyers as a whole not an isolated incident
- Provide a detailed summary of the background facts and the violation committee

Process of Approval:

- 1. TCDLA Prosecutorial Conduct Committee shall review the complaint and determine if it meets the criteria.
- 2. If the case does not meet the criteria, the chair or a committee representative will contact the reporting party offer guidance to file on their own.
- 3. If the complaint meets the criteria, the Prosecutorial Conduct Committee will present a synopsis of the case to the Executive Committee.
- 4. Pending the executive committee's determination if not approved step 3 will be followed. If approved by the committee will draft the complaint to the SBOT of Texas chief disciplinary office.
- 5. The final version will be submitted to EC for approval.
- 6. The grievance will be submitted in the President's name and its members, signed by the TCDLA President.
- 7. The committee chair will handle details of the grievance and list TCDLA ED or staff representative to be able to find status.
